It is exactly sculptural art that inspires the designer Sabine Marcelis for the Block sofa project. It appears to be shaped from a single block that is then carved with great skill to give life to a solid and squared base, but that completes its full realization in the softness of the padding placed upon the structure. The BLOCK sofa introduces an unprecedented dimension of comfort that puts the sofa and those who live it at the centre: a soft sculpture, the absolute protagonist of the environment that hosts it.

Sabine Marcelis interpreted the growing demand of dynamic furniture with a sofa in which the soft shapes of the upholstery are combined with the squared lines of the base. The in-depth research into materials has resulted in exceptionally light elements, which makes them easy to move, thanks to the wheels on the front part of the respective bases. A new, versatile and functional way of enjoying the spaces of the home, opting for balanced solutions to create continuity and well-being.

Precious padding, all certified, guarantee a look and support that do not change over time. Seat and back cushions in high density polyurethane.


Coverings

Sabine Marcelis is a Dutch designer who runs her practice from the harbor of Rotterdam. After graduating from the Design Academy of Eindhoven in 2011, Marcelis began working as an independent designer within the fields of product, installation and spacial design with a strong focus on materiality. Her work is characterized by pure forms which highlight material properties.

Marcelis applies a strong aesthetic point of view to her collaborations with industry specialists. This method of working allows her to intervene in the manufacturing process, using material research and experimentation to achieve new and surprising visual effects for projects both showcased in musea and commissioned by commercial clients and fashion houses. Sabine considers her designs to be true sensorial experiences and not simple static works: the experience becomes the function, with a refined and unique aesthetic.

Sabine recently won the prestigious Wallpaper awards 'Designer of the year 2020', the Design Prize 2019 in the 'Newcomer of the year' category, The Elle Deco International Design award 2019 'Young designer of the year' and 'GQ Men of the year 2019' International Artist of the year.
